Jewish Kabbalah

Jewish Tradition is monotheistic with the concept of “one” God. However, in Jewish Kabbalah God manifests as multiple male and female personalities and names. This is called “Partzufim”. The Partzufim are created as God’s light and energy move from the supernal realm into creation. Each personality is separate and unique even though emanating from the one “God”.

Gnosticism

Gnosis means “to Know” and refers to any spiritual movement that involves personal experiential knowledge of the Divine. In the early Christian movement there were several sects of “Gnostics” who mixed Christianity, Jewish Mysticism, and Greek Philosophy into a vibrant mystical Tradition.

Name	Tradition	Description
Ain	Kabbalah	God beyond creation. The No Thing that emanates everything.

Ain Sof	Kabbalah	God as endless light.
Ain Sof Or	Kabbalah	Gad as eternity.
Ehieh	Kabbalah	Ehieh means "I Am". At the burning bush God tells Moses that his name is Ehieh Asher Ehieh ("I Am Who I Am"). This is God at the Sefirot of Keter where He/She is both male and female.
YHWH or Yahweh	Kabbalah	YHWH (Yod Heh Vav Heh in Hebrew) means "One is was, is, and will be". The letters stand for the Partzufim Father, Mother, Son, & Daughter. YHWH is Father God at the Sefirot of Hokmah. Force of God.
Elohim	Kabbalah	God who manifests as multiple male and female personalities. Elohim is God the Mother at the Sefirot of Binah. Form of God.
El	Kabbalah	God. This is God as Mercy manifesting at the Sefirot of Hesed
Elohim Givur	Kabbalah	Elohim Givur is the Power of God in restriction. This divine name is at the Sefirot of Gevurah.
Yeshua	Kabbalah	Yeshua is the true name for the person that Christians call Jesus. Yeshua is his Aramaic/Hebrew name. Yeshua is YHWH with a Shin put in the middle. It means YHWH Saves. This is the name of the Son at the Sefirot Tiferet.
YHWH Tzavaot	Kabbalah	YHWH Tzavaot is Lord of Hosts and is the name of God at the Sefirot Netzach
Elohim Tzavaot	Kabbalah	Elohim Tzavaot is God of Hosts and is the name of God at the Sefirot Hod.
Shedai, El Shadai, Shadai	Kabbalah	These are the three names of God at the Sefirot Yesod. The three names represent the flow of mercy, compassion, and severity into creation. These

El God		names can refer to the procreative power of God the Father or can be taken as the “many breasted one” of God the Mother.
Adonai	Kabbalah	Adonai means Lord and is the divine name at the Sefirot Malkut. This is God in creation and is actually female.
Shekinah	Kabbalah	God’s presence and power. This is the Kabbalistic equivalent to the Holy Spirit and is God’s consort or God’s wife. Divine Feminine.
Atik Yoman	Kabbalah	“Ancient of Days”. God as an old man or woman sitting in profile. This is the manifestation of God at the beginning of the Cosmic Cycle. Ancient and transcendent.
Arich Anpin	Kabbalah	The “Big Face” of God that is the whole Tree of Life.
Zer Anpin	Kabbalah	The “Small Face” of God that is the revealed aspect of God consisting of the 6 Sefirot of Tiferet in creation.
Abba	Kabbalah	Father God
Imma	Kabbalah	Mother God
Imma Gadol	Kabbalah	Great Mother
Ben	Kabbalah	The Son of God
Nukvah	Kabbalah	The Daughter of God
Kallah	Kabbalah	The Bride.

Mary Magdalene	Kabbalah	Considered by some to be the Partzuf of Malkut. The Daughter and Bride of God.
Lilith	Kabbalah	The Dark Bride. Adam's first wife. Dark Mother.
Na'amah	Kabbalah	Queen of Demons. Lilith in a more wrathful form.
Igaret	Kabbalah	Hag of Chaos. Lilith in her most wrathful form.
Matronet	Kabbalah	God's female consort.
Havvah	Kabbalah	Eve. The original bright Bride and Daughter.
Adam	Kabbalah	The first man and Son.
Samiel	Kabbalah	The poison of God. The Dark Son.
Black Madonna	Gnostic	Divine Mother and Child statues and paintings that are painted "black" for Wisdom. They are representations of Sophia and the enlightened humanity.
Sophia	Gnostic	God's Wisdom. Analogous to Imma and Shekinah in Kabbalah
Logos	Gnostic	God's Word. Analogous to Ben in Kabbalah. The creative force of language.
Pistiis Sophia	Gnostic	Faith Wisdom. A being of light who is tricked into giving up her light. Described in the Gnostic Gospel of the same name.

Barbelo	Gnostic	Great Invisible Spirit who is called Mother. Similar to Sophia.
Zoe	Gnostic	Daughter of Sophia. A Daughter/Bride figure.
Demiurgos	Gnostic	False Creator. Spirit of delusion.
Yaldabaoth	Gnostic	The Lion-Faced One. Spirit of Ego and deception.
